2. Eligibility - All contestants must be a resident of Austin County, Texas and/or enrolled in the Sealy, Bellville or Brazos Independent School Districts from the start of the current school year. The 2010 & prior Little Miss Fantasy title holders will not be eligible to compete in this division.
3. Pageant
