Forms of payment accepted is cash or check made payable to the Sealy Community Foundation. All applications along with participation fees must be postmarked or hand delivered no later than October 26, 2009. There will be no exceptions. You can contact Lisa at 979-885-8591 for more information.

2. Eligibility - All contestants must be a resident of Austin County, Texas and/or enrolled in the Sealy, Bellville or Brazos Independent School Districts from the start of the current school year. The 2008 & prior Little Miss Fantasy title holders will not be eligible to compete in this division.

3. Pageant - a.) Each contestant will wear a Church Dress. This will be a dressy dress worn to church, no longer than 4" below the knees. MAKEUP IS NOT ALLOWED. The contestant must look natural. Contestants not following these guidelines will be disqualified and no refunds will be issued.

b.) Each contestant will be asked the questions on their application by the Master of Ceremonies.

c.) Talent is not part of the pageant and will not influence judging in any way.

4. Winners - There will be up to 5 winners selected, depending on the number of contestants participating in the pageant. The winners will consist of a Queen and 4 Runner-ups. All contestants will receive a participation award.

5. Miss Photogenic - This is an optional category. An additional \$5.00 fee per contestant will be charged and due at the same time of application along with the photograph. Only one photo will be allowed. The photograph must be no larger than a 5x7. The photographer will not be judged only the contestant.

6. Judging - Contestants will be judged on the following while On-Stage:

a.) Poise and Personality - Attention is given to the contestant's poise, charm, carriage and the confidence by which she carries herself.

b.) Personal Appearance - Attention is given to the overall appearance and the contestant's sense of style. Scoring is not affected by the price of the clothing. Attire for on-stage judging should be a dressy church dress (as stated in the pageant section).

c.) Self-Presentation - Attention is given to the overall image that is conveyed to the judges by the contestants. Girls are being judged at all times and should present themselves as such.

d.) Responsiveness to Questions - Attention is given to the contestant's communication skills and the substance of her answers.
